

## **Information for authors whose papers have been accepted at LGC 2010**

### **Submission deadline:**

The final manuscript is due by **August 7th**.

### **General instructions:**

- The paper should be submitted as a MS Word (.doc) file by email to: [lgc2010@matf.bg.ac.rs](mailto:lgc2010@matf.bg.ac.rs).
- Paper size should be A4.
- Paper margins should be as follows: top 2.6cm, bottom 2.3cm, left 1.8cm, right 1.8cm.
- The paper must not exceed the length of 8 pages (including pictures and tables).
- Pictures should be sent as separate files in .jpg format, resolution 300 dpi or higher.
- Insert picture number in the picture file name, e.g. Picture01, Picture02, etc.
- Mark the space for the picture in the paper with the picture name in red font and leave the caption below (if there is one).
- Width of pictures and tables should not exceed 16cm.

Author/s name and surname (Times New Roman, 12pt)

Institution, University (Times New Roman, 12pt)

e-mail (Times New Roman, 12pt)

Abstract (Times New Roman, 10pt, justified, single spaced)

Keywords (Times New Roman, 10pt, justified, single spaced)

Main<sup>1</sup> text (Times New Roman, 12pt, justified, single spaced, indented 0.7cm left - first line only). Please take care that text is now single spaced, and not 1.5 line space. Avoid using underline text.

*Text examples and quotations (Times New Roman, 10pt, italic, single spaced, without indent)*

Chapter numbering: (Times New Roman, 11pt, Arab numbers, left-justified)

1.1.1. (if possible, do not go beyond 3 levels)

If making list, use dashed list

If using tables	set line weight to 1/4pt	and use Times New Roman 10pt for cell text

(Times New Roman, 10pt, justified, single spaced, indentation – hanging 0.7cm [Format / Paragraph – Indents and Spacing])
